ANTI RAGGING CELL

WHAT IS RAGGING?

- Misconduct of any student either in spoken or written form or any action that has the effect of harming others.
- Indulging in undisciplined activities that cause physical or psychological harm or fear or apprehension.
- Asking others to do things that they normally will not do and cause a sense of shame or emotional embarrassment.
- Any act that disrupts other academic activity.
- Financial extortion or forceful monetary burden on a fresher or any other student.
- Any act of physical abuse including sexual, homosexual assaults, stripping of clothes, forcing obscene lewd acts and gestures causing physical and mental torture.
- Any act of abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults to derive sadistic pleasure.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of any student with or without intent to derive sadistic pleasure or priority over others.

Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in C.L.BAID METHA COLLEGE OF PHARMACY. The college shall take strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging. An offence of Ragging may be charged either on a written complaint by the affected or an independent finding of the Anti Ragging Cell. The Students can register a complaint by directly contacting the chairman of Anti-ragging cell in person or online through the student grievance/complaint redressal form.

OBJECTIVE:

The main objectives of this cell are as follows:

- To make the students aware of dehumanizing effect of ragging.
- To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
- To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to notice.
- To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

The Anti ragging cell has two arms: the "Anti Ragging Committee" and the "Anti Ragging Squad"

Anti Ragging Committee's Functions:

- Ragging is inhuman, heinous, uncultured, unethical, immoral and unacceptable.
- Therefore the management has taken following decisions to be implemented in the college as the Government instructions.
- Students should be strictly warned not to resort to ragging activities in any form in the college campus.
- To ensure compliance with the provisions of these regulations and any law for the time being in force concerning ragging and to deal and act promptly with the incidents of ragging brought to its notice.
- To keep tabs on the happenings/events related to ragging in campus or off-campus with in the hostels and other designed places in the premises.
- To conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident or ragging.
- To monitor, direct and oversee the functions and performance of the Anti-Ragging Squads in prevention and curbing of ragging in the institution.

The following steps are to be taken by the Anti Ragging Committee:

- If any student involvement in ragging activities is sufficiently proved, he/she will be suspended from the college.

- Anti Ragging Committee is responsible to take action against the ragging students in the campus.
- If any students who is harassed by ragging he/she should immediately bring it to the notice of Anti Ragging Committee for taking immediate action.
- Anti Ragging Committee members and senior student should take all the measures to instill confidence among the junior students.
- The students can register a complaint by directly contacting the chairman of Anti-ragging cell in person or online through the student grievance/complaint redressal form available in the college website www.clbaidmethecollege.com

ANTI RAGGING SQUAD

- To be vigilant at all hours all around the campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered in inspect such places.
- Conduct anonymous random surveys among fresher's to check whether the campus is indeed free from ragging.
- To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the Anti ragging committee or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be: and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.
- To ensure the display of posters/tabs on in the college campus.
- Also to monitor the welfare of fresh students outside the campus.
- Any other activity the Anti Ragging Committee might delegate to the Squad.


